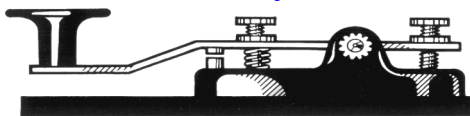

At work, if I start mixing in too much Whiskey Tango I will know its time to retire! **73, Kyle N9OQC**

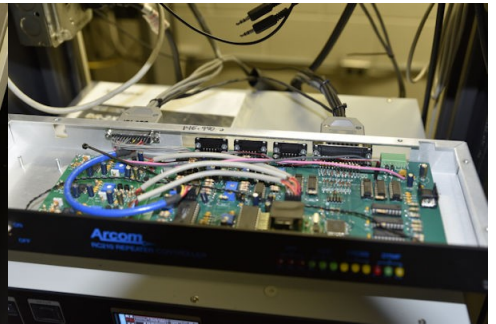
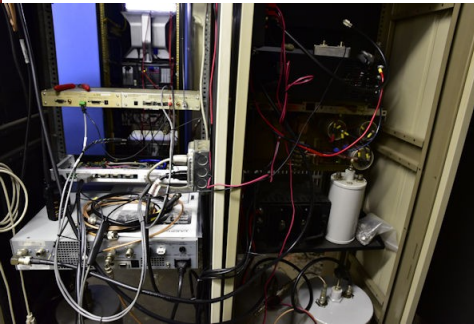
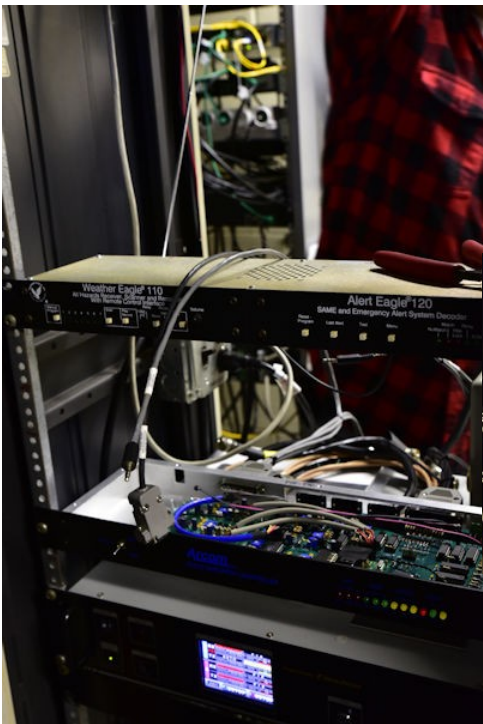
ACTIVITIES AT W9GRS

The February 2021 School Club Round-up officially marked the last year that W9GRS will be operating from the Glenn Raymond School QTH. Earlier this year we were informed that the school district was closing one of the elementary buildings and grades would be consolidated into the remaining 3 buildings. It was decided that grades 1-5 would now occupy Glenn Raymond and the 6-8 grades would be moved to join the high school. This was not a popular choice, but the powers that be wanted it this way.

The long term goal is to build a new school campus, out of the floodplain and provide students with a state of the art facility. A building referendum is going to the voters in April. The passing of the referendum puts the district in the position to get 75% of the total cost paid for with matching grants. So, where does that leave W9GRS? We have begun taking down the station and looking at moving the antennas to an appropriate place at the high school, which has a better elevation and line of sight than Glenn Raymond (read...possible ARISS operations). I will be able to work with high school students in addition to junior high students, to continue the journey they have started at W9GRS.

I have also been tabbed to teach a new STEM rotational elective course for our 7th graders. I wonder where I could get some good hands-on activities for that...hmm. I am also planning on finally applying for a ARRL Progress Grant to upgrade our radio equipment...my eyes are on the Kenwood 590-SG. In terms of radio operations, the plan is to pick up where we left off and establish a station at the new building. We are keeping the W9GRS call, but will rename the station.

We have an appropriate option we would like to go with, but want to wait until antennas and radios are up and running before making that official. We still have a few boxes that need to be checked off before the big move. One is to get some new QSL cards with the Glenn Raymond QTH to get caught up on those we have received recently. Second is to finish up 5-Band Worked All States. W9GRS is currently only 3 slots away from it. Only need Alaska on 80m / 10m and New Mexico on 10m for 5-Band WAS. Even though this chapter of W9GRS is coming to a close, we are looking forward to the new chapter that will be written in the near future! **73, Troy W9KVR/W9GRS**

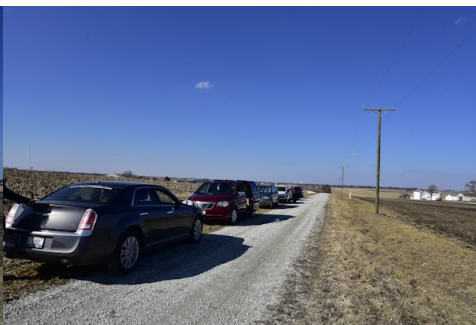
