Former Watsekan 1959 Dies In Plane W9FRN Crash In California

WATSEKA — (JNS) — Funeral services for a former Watsekan, Wayne Fanyo of San Bernardino, Calif., will be held at the Segur Funeral Home here Monday at 2 p. m.

Mr. Fanyo, a Navy lieutenant in World War II, died in an airplane crash in a mountainous and heavily wooded area of California Monday. Two other passengers and the pilot of the plane were also killed in the crash, which occurred during a flight from San Bernardino to Los Angeles.

Mr. Fanyo's body will arrive in Watseka Sunday. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery. KARS Archives 1954

Former Watseka Man Dies In Pecano Plane Crash

WATSEKA —(JNS)— A former Watseka resident was killed Monday in a plane crash in California.

Wayne Fanyo of San Bernadino, Calif., born and reared in this community, died with two other passengers and the pilot when the plane in which they were flying crashed and burned.

Authorities have been unable to determine what caused the mishap. Searchers found the wreckage in mountainous and heavily wooded terrain.

The plane was headed from San Bernadino to Los Angeles. Fanyo's ultimate destination on a business trip was Texas.

He was employed as a technical representative between the Minneapolis-Honeywell firm and the Air Force

Fanyo was married to the former Lucille Plachecki of St. Cloud, Minn. They have a daughter, Sandra Jean, 7.

The plane crashed about 10 minutes out of San Bernadino.

Local survivors include his parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Fanyo, Watseka, a sister, Mrs. Florence Purgett, Chicago, and a brother, Glenn Fanyo of Watseka.

Burial will be in Watseka. Funeral arrangements are incomple e and will be announced.
