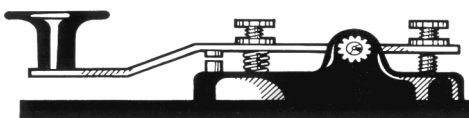

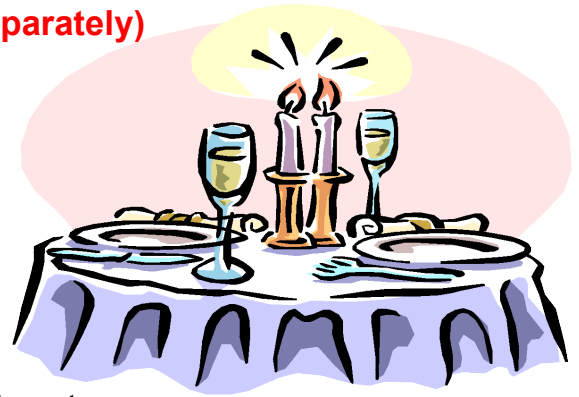

You order and pay for your drinks there.

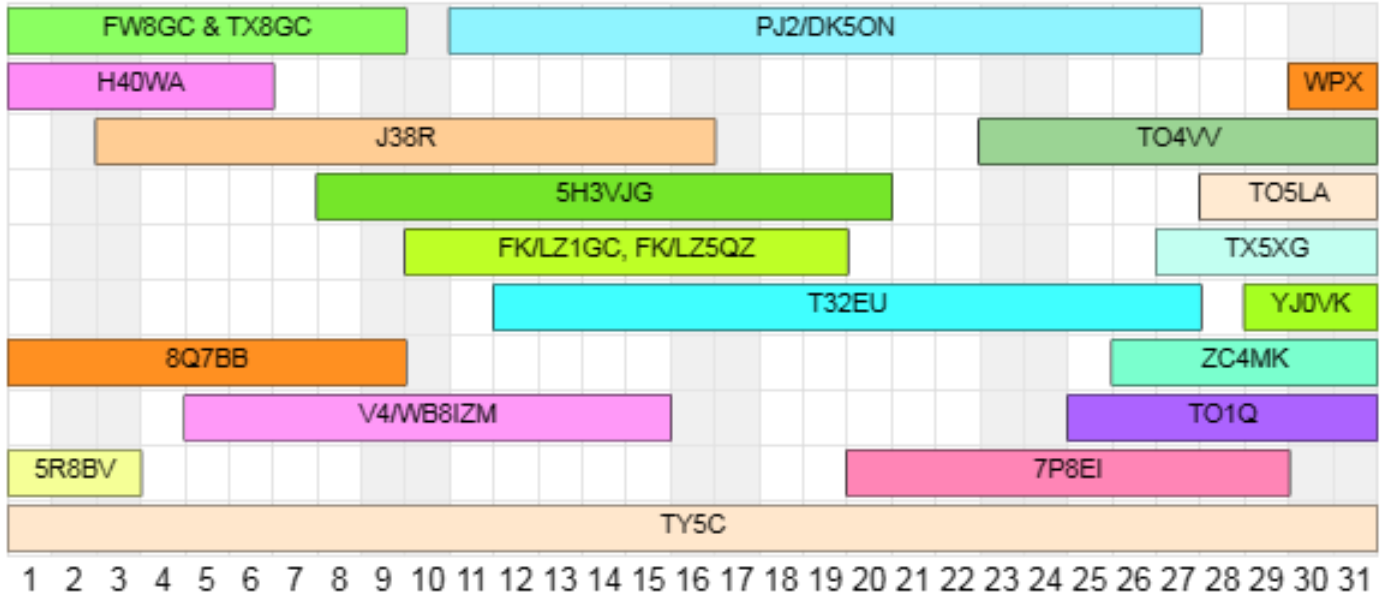

**NWS NOAA Weather Transmitters
Kankakee, Iroquois Counties - 2003**

Through the efforts of KARS (Kankakee Area Radio Society) members Howard Dybedock, AK9F(sk), and Jerry Rosalius, WB9Z, Kankakee and Iroquois counties has two full time National Weather Service VHF transmitters. Howard and Jerry have been working for about six months to convince the weather bureau to locate transmitters here, as the closest VHF weather radios (Chicago and Champaign, both on 162.550 mHz.) lacked the power to penetrate buildings, and often interfered with each other. But recently, Congress provided a new funding allocation which enabled the NWS to buy the equipment to serve additional counties and the Bureau agreed to add stations to our area.
