

The Board has approved \$300 for door prizes. Also, the club will write one check for all, so you must make every effort to pay the club in advance.


Again, everything is covered, **except for alchohol and bar drinks**. You pay your bar bill please. HOPE TO SEE YOU THERE!

RXAssistant has once again been expanded with more features than ever before.

This Windows App is designed to work on all of the 6000 and new 8000 Series Flex Radio SDR radios.

Ken W9IE has been at it once again to make his creation do more of the things that matter to the active DXer, Contester and everyday ham op.

RXAssistant software app for Windows looks and works like previous versions with the addition now of band changes in both the A and B slices and reflects the current band in use.

Some cosmetic color enhancements have been made as well that Ken says are prettier.

Just install over the top of the previously installed version. No fresh installs ever required.

The user and installation documents have also been updated.

RXAssistant is hosted by KARS on the KARS web site and is a free app download enjoyed by ops worldwide. Thank you Ken!
