

Lt. Loftus began his fire service career in December of 1978 and retired as a Lieutenant in October of 1999.

Throughout his career, he achieved many fire certifications and EMT licensures from the State of

Illinois. He was also a dedicated member of the Kankakee County MABAS 7 Fire Investigation Team. His commitment to training was instrumental in ensuring every firefighter had access to additional training opportunities, as he was one of the founding members of the Kankakee County Fire Training Expo Committee.

Lt. Loftus played a key role in the critical upgrade of the county-wide fire and police radio transmission and paging systems during the 1980s and 1990s. He embodied the best qualities of the fire service—a leader, mentor, life coach, and, above all, a friend. His impact was felt not only within the fire service but throughout the community, as he touched countless lives every day.
